Bacseal Super is a long lasting wound and graft sealant containing a fungicide for the control of European canker in pipfruit and silver leaf in pip and summerfruit. Also for application to seal and give protection of grafts, wounds and pruning cuts in kiwifruit, grapes and ornamental trees.

DIRECTIONS FOR USE:

Stir thoroughly before use. Do not dilute **Bacseal Super** with water as the seal integrity will be reduced.

Application: Apply **Bacseal Super** with a paint brush or applicator to a clean surface, in a continuous uniform layer over and beyond (minimum of 1 cm) the edges of the cut surface.

Healthy Wounds: Apply **Bacseal Super** directly after the cut is made.

Infected Wounds (European canker, Silver leaf): All infected, stained wood must be cut out, or alternatively the branch should be cut back to healthy tissue before applying **Bacseal Super**.

Protection of Grafts: Apply **Bacseal Super** after grafting and before or after taping. Do not apply before taping if the union is not perfect, otherwise **Bacseal Super** may penetrate the union and prevent the graft from taking. Where large wounds have



been made check and repaint if cracking appears after the sealant has dried.
Brushes should be washed out in water after use.

Bacseal Super should only be applied to plants during the dormant period.
