**RAXIL® Fungicide**

**Substance:** Red liquid (flowable suspension concentrate) containing 25g/litre tebuconazole (CAS No. 107534-96-3)  
**Proper shipping name:** ENVIRONMENTALLY HAZARDOUS SUBSTANCE, LIQUID N.O.S. (Tebuconazole Mixture)

IF THIS HAPPENS	DO THIS
<b>Tanker/Vehicle Accident</b>	Switch off engine and electrical equipment. Keep people away, warn other traffic. Check for spills, leaks. <b>Call the emergency services: Dial 111</b>
<b>Spill or leak</b>	Keep all bystanders away. Wear goggles, half face-piece respirator with combined dust and vapour cartridge, full length clothing and PVC gloves. Adsorb spilled product and place in a sealable container for disposal. Wash down affected area with water plus detergent. Seek advice from local authority regarding disposal.
<b>Fire</b>	<b>Call the Fire Service: Dial 111.</b> Wear PVC protective clothing and breathing apparatus. Extinguish fires with foam, dry chemical or carbon dioxide or fine-water spray. During a fire toxic fumes may be released. Cool sealed drums with water to prevent rupture due to thermal expansion. Contain run-off. Keep non-involved persons away.

**FIRST AID**

<b>If Swallowed:</b>	Do NOT induce vomiting. <b>For advice contact the National Poisons Centre 0800 POISON (0800 764 766) or a doctor immediately.</b>
<b>If in Eyes:</b>	Hold eyelids apart and flush the eye continuously with running water for at least 15 minutes. Get medical attention.
<b>If on Skin:</b>	If skin or hair contact occurs, remove contaminated clothing and flush skin and hair with running water. Do not scrub the skin.
<b>If Inhaled:</b>	Remove patient to fresh air. If not breathing, give artificial respiration, preferably mouth-to-nose. Get medical attention if symptoms develop.

**STORAGE AND SEGREGATION SUMMARY**

**Storage:** Store in original container in a cool, dry, ventilated place away from direct heat or direct sunlight. Store away from foodstuffs, children and animals. Keep container sealed when not in use.
